NEW TRASH CONTRACTOR

The Board of Directors ended its contract with American Disposal effective March 28, 2024. The new trash contractor is Garby Disposal Services, and they will start collection on April 4, 2024.

AMERICAN DISPOSAL WILL COLLECT ALL OF THEIR TRASH AND RECYCLE BINS ON THURSDAY,

MARCH 28, THE BINS WILL BE EMPTIED FOR THE REGULAR TRASH COLLECTION ON MARCH 27. PLEASE LEAVE AMERICAN BINS OUT MARCH 26 AND LEAVE THEM OUT PERMANENTLY. OWNERS MAY BE CHARGED FOR BINS NOT RETURNED TO AMERICAN DISPOSAL.

EVERYONE NEEDS TO PLACE ALL AMERICAN BINS ON THE CURB BY THURSDAY, MARCH 26.

The new trash contractor, Garby Disposal Services, <u>will deliver your new 65-gallon Trash bin and Recycle bin</u> on MONDAY & TUESDAY, MARCH 25 & 26. (Homeowner is responsible to pay \$70 for a replacement if their new bin is lost or stolen)

TRASH COLLECTION DAYS: Thursday

RECYCLING COLLECTION: <u>Thursday</u>

YARD WASTE COLLECTION: Wednesday (March-December only)

BULK TRASH COLLECTION: Most bulk items (items that do not fit in bins) such as couches, chairs and household items can be picked up for AN ADDITIONAL FEE to the owner. *Bulk pick up requires scheduling*. All "white goods" such as washers, dryers, stoves, and other appliances can be picked up for AN ADDITIONAL FEE. <u>Please call ahead</u> when these items are curbside, as they are not transported by your regular trash truck and a separate truck will need to be scheduled to pick up these items. *If a holiday falls on your pickup day, there will be no pickup. Notice: Pickup will be made <u>on the following</u> <u>Saturday</u>. Holidays are: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, and July 4.

Rules for trash collection:

- Put out your trash for collection by 6am the day of collection.
- Light gray carts with the black lids (or all dark gray/black carts) are only for household trash.
- Light gray carts with the <u>blue lids</u> (or all blue carts) are only for household recycling.
- If the customer provides their own bins, they must have a dark gray/black bin for trash and a

blue bin for recycling. They also must be willing for us to mark them with our information to make it easier for our drivers to spot them.

Unacceptable Materials For Trash And Recycling

- Liquids, septic waste
- Hazardous waste including paint, oil, asbestos, other chemical wastes, batteries
- Compressed cylinders (any size), combustible materials
- Automobile parts and tires
- Construction and demolition debris (drywall, shingles, roofing material, insulation, concrete)
- Animal carcasses
- Broken Glass
- Bio-hazardous medical waste

Recycling Rules:

Put these items FREE OF FOOD AND LIQUID in your recycling cart:

- Plastic bottles and jugs with lids on
- Metal food and beverage cans
- Mixed paper and cardboard
- Cartons

Do NOT put these items in your recycling cart:

- Plastic bags, film and pillow packaging
- Glass
- Food bags and wrappers
- Needles and medical waste
- Shredded paper
- Diapers
- Mixed (paper and plastic intertwined) packaging
- Hangers, hoses, and cables
- Clothing
- Foam and plastic takeout cups and containers
- Batteries

Yard Waste Rules:

- Each year from March 1 through December 24, yard waste (grass, leaves, and trimmings) must be collected separately.
- Reusable containers designated for yard waste or compostable paper yard waste bags may be used.
- Branches must not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- Yard waste does not included soil, mulch, sod, stumps, whole trees (except Christmas trees on a specified date - see below), large branches, limbs, invasives, or bamboo.
- No more than 10 20-gallon bags, and no plastic bags for yard waste.
- There is a special Christmas tree collection during the first two weeks of January. Christmas trees must be free of any decorations and must purely be the tree itself.

Special Pickup:

Special/bulk pickup must be scheduled by contacting us either by social media, text, email, or calling. Additional charges may apply.
